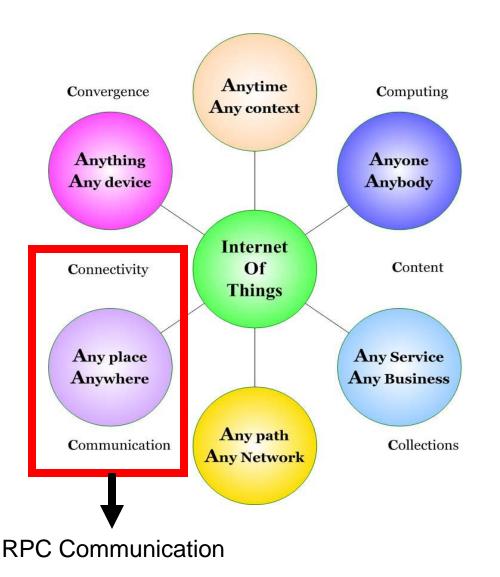

Internet of Things



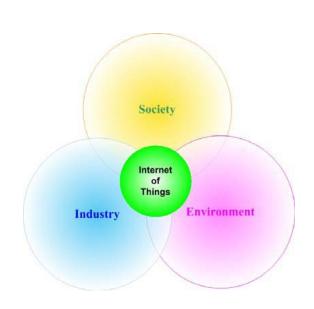


- an integrated part of Future Internet

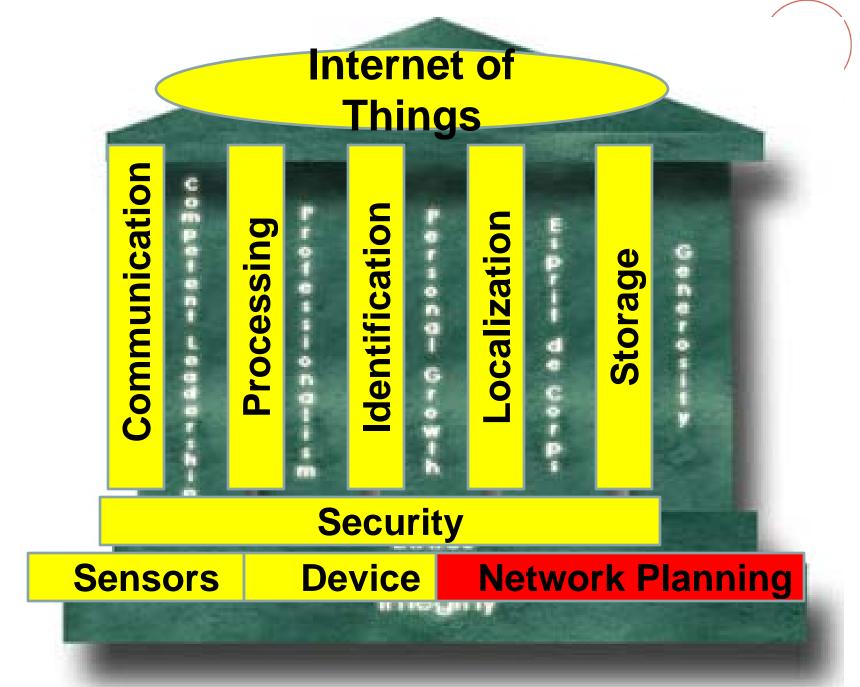

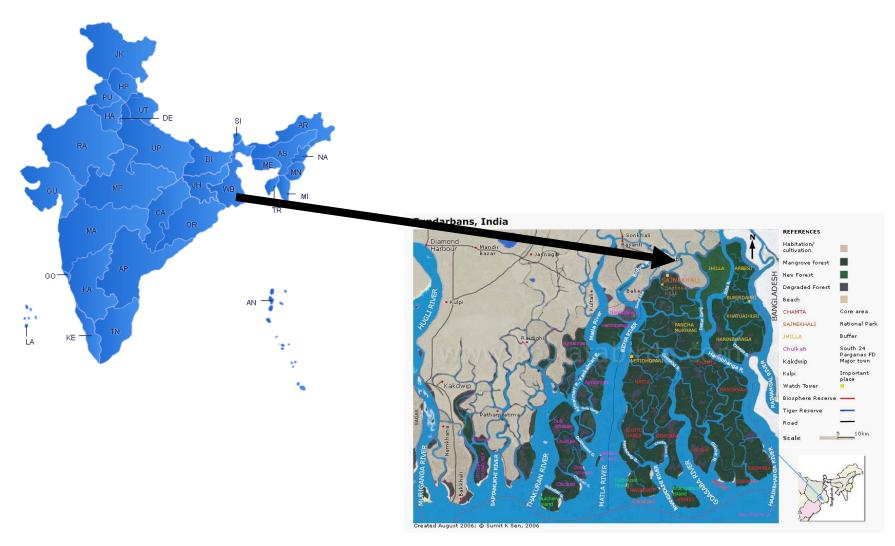


- To provide internet connectivity to rural area for achiving basic needs.

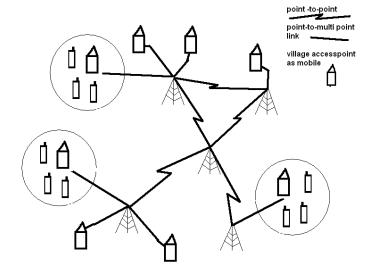

Mobile broadband	< 1% Global	VoIP, email, file, web

Possible Solution

- Make use of mobiles as sensor nodes for reaching to destination.

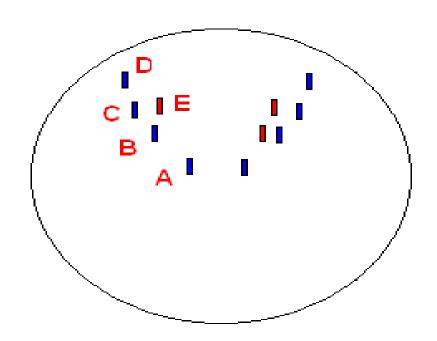




Mobile as Medium for transmission
